Congratulations, you have been selected All-State in Volleyball by the Colorado Coaches of Girls' Sports (CCGS). Along with this honor, you have been invited to play in the CCGS All-State Games and attend a banquet in your honor.

The CCGS Games Committee is working hard to make the 2008-09 CCGS All-State Games exciting and memorable. The All-State Games are played the week after the completion of the State Tournament. There will be no conflicts for you as players, and you will be in great shape to play volleyball. We will see the best senior talent in the State.

During the past 30 years, the CCGS All-State Games have grown into a prestigious event honoring outstanding senior female athletes, such as you, participating in basketball, volleyball and softball.

The All-State Volleyball Games will be played Sunday, November 16, 2008, at Broomfield High School. There will be five games – 1A, 2A, 3A, 4A and 5A.

Registration and practice on November 15 will be held at Broomfield High School. Team pictures will be taken following registration. Please bring your uniforms to registration. You will have practice and be involved in other activities with your All-State coaches to prepare you for your game. Lunch will not be served but snacks will be provided.

Saturday evening there will be a **semi-formal** (no jeans, please) banquet honoring volleyball athletes and their parents. Advance reservations are required.
